4. Please provide as much detail and information in your application as possible. Incomplete or vague answers are difficult to evaluate and may not be considered. If a question does not apply, please write "not applicable."
5. Late applications will not be considered.
6. Letters of recommendation are not required for scholarship consideration, but may be helpful. If you wish to submit an endorsement by a mentor or teacher or case worker, please attach it to your application.
7. Students should be available to attend the EMCC Volunteer and Scholarship Awards Dinner on Friday, June 1st, 2018 at 6:30 pm.
