The **Woody Carey Community Scholarship Program** was started in the fall of 2013 after the passing of long-term board member Dr. Ellwood "Woody" Carey. Woody served as a volunteer on the EMCC Board of Directors for over 25 years and held various Board positions over his tenure. In addition, Woody was one of the original members of the Center's fundraising group, the EMCC Resource Development Team. He was asked to become a member of the team due to his positive attitude and extensive contacts in the community.

The "Scholarship Program" is a meaningful and long lasting tribute to Woody's legacy, loving spirit, and positive values, especially in the area of equal opportunities. This program is especially meaningful because when he went to college the scholarships he obtained were essential to him being able to afford to attend.

East Madison Community Center awards merit-based scholarships of \$500-\$2,000 each, annually. We are now accepting applications for 2023 scholarships.

Eligible applicants:

- Current high school seniors or returning college students;
- Must be pursuing post-secondary education in an accredited 4-year, 2-year, technical institute, or trade school during the 2023-2024 academic year;
- Special consideration will be given to Truax and Webb-Rethke CDA residents, EMCC program participants, EMCC volunteers and first-time applicants.

Completed applications and all supporting materials must be submitted to the East Madison Community Center via email or in person no later than 4:00pm on Friday, May 26th, 2023.

Applications will be scored on the following criteria: Explanation of scholarship need, connection to EMCC, personal and professional goals, participation in school and community, appearance of the application and letters of recommendation.

Scholarship awards will be paid directly to the school.

- 5. Late applications will not be considered.
- 6. Letters of recommendation are not required for scholarship consideration, but may be helpful. If you wish to submit an endorsement by a mentor or teacher or case worker, please attach it to your application.
